Dear Nurses,

<u>Training Subsidy for Registered Nurses to</u> <u>Support Primary Healthcare Development in Hong Kong</u>

The Government is committed to enhancing primary healthcare and will progressively set up District Health Centres (DHCs) in 18 districts to establish a prevention-centered primary healthcare system in Hong Kong. By end of June 2022, four District Health Centres (DHCs) have been established in Kwai Tsing, Shum Shui Po, Tuen Mun and Wong Tai Sin. It is expected that the Southern and Yuen Long DHCs will start operation in October this year, and Tsuen Wan by end of 2022 respectively. In addition, 11 DHC Expresses across the city have already commenced operation progressively starting from September last year.

Nurses, acting as care coordinators (CC) at DHCs, will focus on coordinating healthcare, social and welfare services according to the needs of the client in a holistic approach, providing counselling, enhancing health literacy and promoting individual involvement in healthcare management. **The Post-registration Certificate Course in Primary Health Care Nursing (District Health Center Module) (PRCCPHCN)** organized by the Hong Kong Academy of Nursing (HKAN) and the Hong Kong College of Community and Public Health Nursing is designed taking reference to the expected scope of services of nurses working in the

community providing primary, secondary to tertiary preventive care. It provides the nursing profession with knowledge, skills and attitude on primary and community care in particular health communication, counselling and empowerment, use of non-pharmacological intervention, etc.

The course will be commenced in Oct 2022 and is now open for application. Nurses in Hong Kong who are holders of valid practising certificates issued by the Nursing Council as Registered Nurse with more than five years of post-registration clinical experience may apply for the course. Please refer to the Annex for course details. Participants who have fulfilled the course requirements and attained the Certificate may apply through HKAN to Health Bureau for reimbursement of HK\$3,000 within 6 months after completion. The final approval of the reimbursement is at the discretion of the Government.
